This store will replace the current location already in the market and is slated to open in 2027.

Seminole guests will also experience expanded services in this new location, such as a full-service deli with fresh, hot foods, ReadyMeals, and a dining area, including new items across the departments. Perhaps best of all, with the addition of the United Express, guests can redeem rewards points on fuel for up to a \$1 off per gallon.

"We are proud to welcome this new, larger United Supermarkets grocery store, and we are especially grateful to the Seminole Economic Development Corporation board members for their hard work and dedication in making this vision a reality," said Mayor Chet Clark, City of Seminole.
